

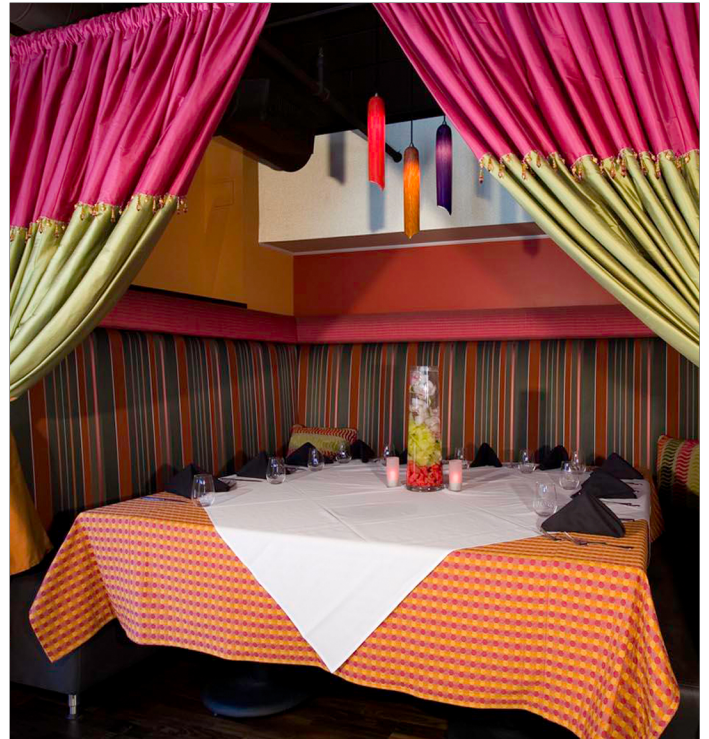
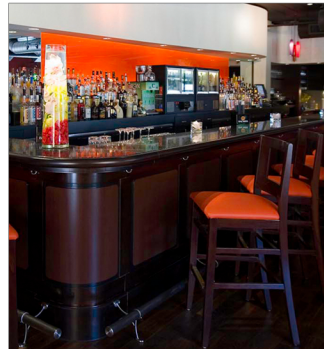

PROJECT SCOPE:

New restaurant design and construction.

CHALLENGE:

Local restaurateur John Elkay wanted his wine bar and bistro to have a comfortable lounge feel with the right mix of open space and privacy created by large, curving seating elements. The major challenge on this project was that the back half of the restaurant was built into a parking garage. As one may be aware, parking platforms are purposefully made to move and flex, much like the way a bridge is engineered to move as vehicles pass over them. However, the structure that the restaurant is located in is not designed for movement. Cobalt had to work out the engineering and stability details in order to make this project work.
